FACULTY ASSOCIATE APPLICATION

The number of faculty associates appointed will generally be limited one per semester. To be eligible the faculty member's department and college must commit to releasing him or her from at least one three-credit hour course. It is important that applicants submit a complete packet including the application form with the department chair and college dean's approval, and a proposal outlining their goals as a faculty associate. Applications are due on 1 March for a fall or academic year appointment and 1 October for a spring appointment.

* Required documentation and information must be provided to receive full consideration*

- 1. Draft Proposal. Explanation of the applicant's goals as a faculty associate and the expected long-range outcomes for the faculty associate, department and college.
2. Support Recommendations: Comments from Department Chair and College Dean are required. Absence of substantive comments from the Department Chair or Dean will adversely affect a proposal. Additional statements of support may be provided. Departments or colleges are expected to release the faculty associate from at least one three-credit hour course.
